In the Prisoner's Dilemma:

Confessing is a better strategy for JG – regardless of what strategy JK chooses to follow.

Similarly, confessing is a better strategy for JK – regardless of what strategy JG chooses to follow.

Both have an obvious strategy they should choose, and so we can predict the final outcome of the game.

In our in-class example:

Confessing is a better strategy for Colin – regardless of what strategy Rose chooses to follow

Rose does not have a strategy that's always best for her
