

- **Original Question:** Can we show that a system which was not originally defined to be weighted actually is weighted?

**Answer:** Yes! We showed that the UN Security council is weighted, even though the powers-that-be didn't explicitly give each country weights.

*That leads us to ...*

- **New Question:** Is every yes-no voting system weighted?

**Answer:** No. every weighted voting system is swap robust, and the U.S. Fed. system is not swap robust.
