• Original Question: Can we show that a system which was not originally defined to be weighted actually is weighted?

Answer: Yes! We showed that the UN Security council is weighted, even though the powers-that-be didn't explicitly give each country weights.

That leads us to ...

• New Question: Is every yes-no voting system weighted?

Answer: No. every weighted voting system is swap robust, and the U.S. Fed. system is not swap robust.

Weighted Voting System \Rightarrow Swap Robust Voting System

• Another New Question: Is being swap robust equivalent to being weighted? In other words, do we also have

Swap Robust Voting System $\stackrel{?}{\Rightarrow}$ Weighted Voting System?

Answer No! It turns out that the Canadian system to amend the constitution is swap robust but is not a weighted voting system.
